MASTER OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY LAW

The Master of Intellectual Property Law, commencing in February 2010, is offered jointly by the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) and QUT's Faculty of Law in Brisbane, Australia.

This innovative course was developed in partnership with WIPO and is unique to the Asia-Pacific region.

The Masters course provides knowledge of IP law, policy and practice in an international context with an emphasis on the Asia-Pacific region.

MASTER OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY LAW SCHOLARSHIP FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Commencing in 2010, the Faculty of Law is offering **two** full fee waiver scholarships to international students from countries in the Asia-Pacific region (excluding Australia and New Zealand). The scholarships will be awarded based on academic merit in the applicant's undergraduate degree. Work experience in the intellectual property area, where applicable, also will be taken into consideration. Applicants must meet all other academic and English language requirements for the Master of Intellectual Property Law to be considered for this scholarship.

APPLICATION

Applicants should include with their application for entry to the course a written statement advising that they wish to be considered for the Faculty of Law fee waiver scholarship. Supporting statements should include details of the relevant work experience in the intellectual property area.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION CLOSING DATES

Applications for entry to the course together with a supporting statement must be lodged by **1 December 2009** for 2010 course commencement.

Successful applicants will be advised by 21 December 2009.
